Age 4 is recommended for second measles dose

The Ministry of Health has published a "Measles Questions and Answers for Public Health Units" document to accompany the Measles Appendix 1 of the Infectious Diseases Protocol of the Public Health Standards.

Refer to Section C, Question 16:

The optimal timing for the 4-to-6-year MMRV dose is **at 4 years of age**. This is especially important if a child is attending day care or school.

<u>ACTION</u>: Prioritize MMRV immunizations for all children in your roster as soon as they are 4 years of age. Do not delay this second dose. Ask families to report this vaccination to SWPH by visiting www.swpublichealth.ca/vaccineswork.
