

## Public Health Update - July 2018

## Are your pediatric patients eating enough fruits and vegies? Maybe not.

From the Elgin St. Thomas 2017 Preschool NutriSTEP® Report we know that:

- 314 caregivers of children ages 3-5 completed the nutrition screen in 2017.
- 7% are at high nutrition risk; 15% at moderate nutrition risk; 78% at low nutrition risk.
- Our preschoolers are not eating enough veggies and fruit.
  - > 33.5% eat veggies once a day or less.
  - ➤ 45.9% eat fruit twice a day or less.
- 44% of our preschoolers are at risk for consuming excess fast food.
- 32.5% of our parents may be exerting too much influence over how much their child eats.
- 73.6% of preschool children are at risk for excess screen time for their age.
