



Healthy Smiles Ontario

A government-funded program designed for families in need of support.

Q What free services does Healthy Smiles Ontario provide?

A Teeth cleaning, check-ups and dental treatments for kids.

Q Who is this free dental care program for?

A Children 17 and under, from Ontario, who fit income requirements.

Q Who is automatically enrolled in the program?

A Children who receive assistance under: Temporary Care Assistance, Assistance for Children with Severe Disabilities OR they or their family receive: Ontario Works / Ontario Disability Support.

Q Does Healthy Smiles Ontario provide emergency dental care?

A Yes. To qualify, your child must have a clinical need and show financial hardship. You will be asked some questions about how you or your family would be affected if you had to pay for dental treatment. For example, would you be unable to pay household bills if you had to pay for dental treatment?



Who can apply for non-emergency care?



You can apply for your children if they are: 17 years of age and under, live in Ontario, come from a household with an income equal to or less than the levels in the table below.

Before you start

Before you begin the online application, you'll need:

- 1 Your child(ren)'s date(s) of birth.
- 2 A valid Ontario address your Social Insurance Number (SIN) or Temporary Taxation Number (TTN).
- 3 To have filed your taxes in the previous year.

Did you know?

Southwestern Public Health connects families to the Healthy Smiles Ontario program through school dental screenings.

Income eligibility requirements

# of dependent children in your household	Family net income (as of July 1, 2024)
1 child	\$27,746 or lower
2 children	\$29,846 or lower
3 children	\$31,946 or lower
4 children	\$34,046 or lower
5 children	\$36,146 or lower
6 children	\$38,246 or lower
7 children	\$40,346 or lower
8 children	\$42,446 or lower
9 children	\$44,546 or lower
10 or more	\$46,646 or lower

Add \$2,100 for each additional dependent child to determine the income level at which your family would qualify for Healthy Smiles Ontario.
